• Sam Case	13.60
• Yaquina View	10.00
• Newport Middle	13.00
• Newport High	<u>18.00</u>
Total	54.60

# Why Reconfiguration?

- Allow for space for full day kindergarten
- Bond dollars and Construction Excise Tax funding can be used for classroom construction/remodels
- Provide more focused learning opportunities per grade level in each building
- Newport High is at full capacity. Would allow to add programs/teachers

# Why Full Day Kindergarten?

- Contributes to school readiness
- Leads to higher academic achievement
- Improves student attendance
- Supports literacy and language development
- Sam Case math/reading scores are below or at state average.

(Oregon Department of Education 1/14)

# Options for Consideration

1. Add four classrooms to Sam Case
2. Create two K-5's, a 6-8 and a 9-12.
3. Create a K-2, a 3-5, a 6-8 and a 9-12.

# Newport Area Proposed Reconfiguration 2015-2016

- K-2 Yaquina View (430)
- 3-5 Sam Case (422)
- 6-8 Newport Immediate\*(401)
- 9-12 Newport High School(613)

# Financial Implications

## LCSD Remodel/Reconfiguration

- Waldport- \$9,000
- Toledo- \$40,000
- Lincoln City- \$450,000
- Newport- \$670,000

Total \$1.169 Million
