

DESCRIPTION OF MAJOR PROPOSED PROJECTS

to be funded by \$63 million general obligation bond measure



NORTH AREA SCHOOLS

OCEANLAKE ELEMENTARY

Built 1951 Grades K-6 Approx. 400 students

Approx. 23,400-square-foot addition to south end of building would include five classrooms, music room, learning center, main entrance, school office, restrooms, conference room, staff room, and gym.

Two existing classrooms would be remodeled into computer room and media center.

Five portable buildings would be removed. Seven classrooms would be repaired or remodeled.

TAFT ELEMENTARY

Built 1951 Grades K-6 Approx. 410 students

10,400-square-foot addition to west end of building would include six classrooms and restrooms.

Four portable buildings would be removed.

TAFT HIGH

Built 1997 Grades 7-12 Approx. 730 students

Roof would be replaced. Repairs would be made to air-handling and plumbing systems.

SOUTH AREA SCHOOLS

CRESTVIEW HEIGHTS

Built 1997 Grades K-8 Approx. 390 students

Media center would be enlarged into adjoining classroom to serve proposed high school and existing school. Four classrooms would be remodeled for use by proposed high school.

WALDPORTR HIGH

Built 1958 Grades 9-12 Approx. 235 students

An approx. 54,000-square-foot high school would be constructed on district-owned property directly adjacent to the existing Crestview Heights School. The two buildings would be physically separated and have own entries, but would share media center and kitchen.

EAST AREA SCHOOLS

TOLEDO ELEMENTARY

Built 1987 Grades K-6 Approx. 370 students

Approx. 23,400-square-foot addition to north side of building would include 10 classrooms, new school office, and cafeteria.

Eleven portable buildings would be removed. Existing school offices would be remodeled into classrooms. Kitchen would be expanded.

TOLEDO JR/SR HIGH

Built 1955 Grades 7-12 Approx. 350 students

Approx. 13,500-square-foot addition would include construction of four classrooms, commons, elevator addition, weight room and locker rooms.

Gym and staff room would be remodeled. ADA ramps would be provided to shop and football field. Parking lot would be lowered to main level.

Seven portable buildings would be removed.

WEST AREA SCHOOLS

SAM CASE PRIMARY

Built 1958 Grades K-3 Approx. 500 students

Approx. 10,200-square-foot addition would include gymnasium, restrooms and storage at west end of building, and two classrooms at east end of building.

NEWPORT INTERMEDIATE/ ISAAC NEWTON

Built 1997 NIS: Grades 4-6 Approx. 335 students

INMS: Grades 6-8 Approx. 130 students

4,900-square-foot covered play structure would be constructed on west side of existing gymnasium.

NEWPORT PREP ACADEMY (NHS WEST CAMPUS)

Built 1950 Grades 7-8 Approx. 180 students

Approx. 3,500-square-foot addition of two classrooms and restrooms would be built on west side of building. Two portable buildings would be removed.

NEWPORT HIGH SCHOOL

Built 1950 Grades 9-12 Approx. 590 students

Approx. 9,700-square-foot addition would include four classrooms and a band/choir room. Existing shop, two science rooms and restrooms would be remodeled.

Four portable buildings would be removed.

This is not a complete list of proposed projects, but reflects the major projects.

If bond measure is approved, a citizen oversight committee would be appointed to oversee the finalization of plans.
