Dear Parents and Community Members,

This report card by the Oregon Department of Education offers a picture of Taft 7-12. In the 2012-13 school year, Taft 7-12 received an Overall State Rating of Level 2. This rating falls above 5% and below 16% of other schools in terms of academic achievement, graduation and subgroup academic grow.

Key academic highlights:

Overall, Taft 7-12 exceeded the state growth target in reading. 68% of Taft juniors met or exceeded Oregon writing standards on the state-wide assessment.

While reading and writing are meeting growth targets, growth has been inconsistent in mathematics. We are addressing this by

focusing on standards implementation, mathematical practices, and addressing balanced math delivery, while continuing to focus on content literacy.

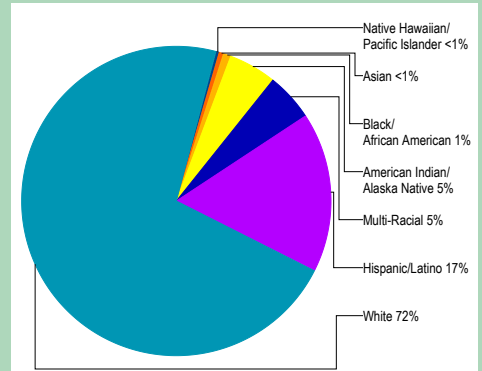

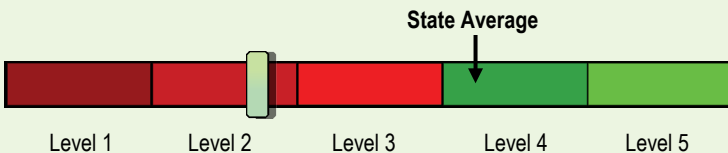


OVERALL STATE RATING

HOW ARE STUDENTS AT THIS SCHOOL PERFORMING COMPARED TO THOSE AT OTHER SCHOOLS?

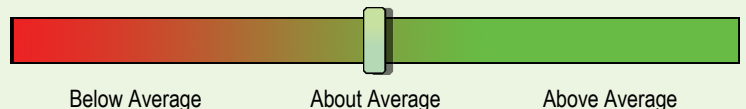
The overall state rating is intended to summarize this school's particular successes and challenges. It is based on a combination of up to five factors. Three of these factors come from standardized test scores in reading and math: student achievement, student growth, and the growth of underserved subgroups. High schools are also rated on the overall graduation rate for the school and the graduation rates of underserved subgroups. Please be aware that this rating is based mainly on high-stakes testing and accordingly, represents a limited view of student performance. Other aspects of this report card are designed to put this rating in the proper context.

Compared to all schools statewide in 2012-13, this school is rated as Level 2.



- Level 1** = Falls into the bottom 5% of schools
- Level 2** = Falls between 5% and 15% of schools
- Level 3** = Falls between 15% and 44% of schools
- Level 4** = Falls between 44% and 90% of schools
- Level 5** = Falls into the top 10% of schools
