Radon

Lincoln County School District has adopted a radon plan as required by ORS 332.167. Community members can access a copy of the radon plan online at <https://lincoln.k12.or.us/our-district/public-reports/> . Test results will be made public and posted to the same website when they become available.

Lead in Drinking Water

Following the Oregon Department of Education and Oregon Health Authority recommendations, Lincoln County School District will test for lead in school water and take corrective action if lead levels are elevated at all schools before December 31, 2016. LCSD will utilize the EPA's 3Ts technical guide for performing the testing by identifying sources of lead, stopping drinking access to water sources exceeding 20 parts per billion, communicating results, mitigating and correcting. Lincoln County School District will follow state guidelines for all future lead drinking water testing and monitoring, with testing of drinking fountains to take place no less than once every ten years.

Lead Paint

In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rule, Lincoln County School District has eight Maintenance Staff members who are Certified Lead Renovators to test, monitor and perform maintenance on all lead containing materials within our facilities.

IPM

Lincoln County School District has adopted an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) plan as required by ORS 634.700 through 634.750. Community members can access a copy of the IPS plan at <http://policy.osba.org/lincoln/E/EBB%20D1.PDF>.

Bus Idling

Lincoln County School District and Mid Columbia Bus Company work to ensure school busses are turned off while waiting at schools to reduce emissions within our community.

Charter Schools

Lincoln County School District has two facilities operated by Charter School Agreements that operate independent of LCSD maintenance.
