- Approximately 9 weeks each term
- .50 or a semester class per term
- Possible for 8.0 total credits per year (7.0 with a traditional 7 period day)
- Bell Schedule 9 am - 3:30 pm daily
 - 80 minute periods
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
Synchronous Learning
 - Wednesday Asynchronous
 - Periods 1 & 2 before lunch and 3 & 4 after

IB Schedule

- Each IB Course will be offered over two terms for the equivalent of 1.0 credits per class
- Courses with Exams in May will be offered Terms 1-3
- Exceptions:
 - IB SR English HL/IB World History HL
 - IB Math Analysis 2 (IB Math SL) will be Term 1 & 4 plus zero period Terms 2 & 3
- IB Test Preparation Review - Term 4
- **Must be enrolled in Comprehensive Distance Learning for IB.** Can not be enrolled in Edmentum Online K-12

Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL) Course Schedule

- 4 Terms
- 4 classes per term
- Approximately 9 weeks each term
- .50 or a semester class per term
- Possible for 8.0 total credits per year (7.0 with a traditional 7 period day)
- Bell Schedule 9 am - 3:30 pm daily
 - 80 Minute Periods
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
Synchronous Learning
 - Wednesday Asynchronous
 - Periods 1 & 2 before lunch and 3 & 4 after
- Approximately 45 minutes of “live” teaching per period
- Approximately 3 hours total per day of “live”

Slow Start to Hybrid

- Lots of safety upgrades

 - ELL Services

Slow Start to Hybrid

- Eventually moving to Hybrid
 - Small Groups (15ish)
 - Attend the same 4 courses
 - Teacher moves or students move
 - Breakfast and Lunch in the classroom
 - A/B Groups
 - Class of 30 is split on A and B days to get the 15 in each Cohort
 - Attend Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday
