Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL)

- Provides students an in-depth, rigorous academic experience to ensure CDL feels more like a traditional school model
- Building teams will create regular, predictable schedules, and routines for daily online activities
- Quality whole group and small group direct instruction led by building teachers
- Synchronous learning for students (two-way communication, video conferences, phone calls with staff, and instructional interventions)
- Opportunities for collaboration with peers and staff
- Regular check-ins with building staff, Mental Health Services - SEL Curriculum
- Comprehensive Distance Learning option will follow attendance guidelines put in place by the Oregon Department of Education

E-Learning (Edmentum)

- K-12 Curriculum aligned to CCSS, NGSS, and Oregon State Standards that is fully online
- Asynchronous Learning

- Students enrolled with a full schedule of courses to meet grade-level standards and graduation requirements
- The self-paced curriculum allows students to accelerate their learning and review when needed

- Students who enroll in the E-Learning program are able to participate in community nights and other school-sponsored events
- Students who enroll in E-Learning will work with building counselors for schedules and have the ability to access social and emotional learning groups and curriculum

Elementary E-Learning Curriculum (K-6):

Study Island: Encourages proficiency towards grade-level and meets Common Core State Standards in English Language Arts, Math, Social Studies, and Science. Study Island ensures that students receive grade-level content while providing interventions (building blocks) to help students achieve a deeper understanding of content areas.

Exact Path: Promotes student academic growth by creating an individualized learning path for each student to ensure students are met at their academic level. Exact Path has the ability to provide enrichment and intervention based on a student's individualized learning path.

Secondary E-Learning Curriculum (7-12):

Courseware: Guidance Counselors will create schedules for students based on academic requirements enrolled within the E-Learning program. Students will have the ability to work at their own pace but will need to abide by the ODE's attendance guidelines and building term start and end dates. Students will participate and engage daily while working towards course completion and/or graduation requirements. Teachers will have scheduled office hours to ensure students are supported in content areas.
