

## Taft 7-12: Virtual Family Night FAQs

- When will students pick up their Chromebooks?
  - In tonight's presentation, information is posted regarding student orientation. Students will return Chromebooks during their assigned grade level time and receive new devices for the year.
    - 7th/8th Grade: September 8th
    - 9th-12th Grade: September 9th
  - If those times do not work, you can schedule with a building administrator. We are available M-F, 8:00-3:30.
  
- What students need to exchange their Chromebooks?
  - At this time, 7th & 8th graders have the older models. If you have any questions, your student can bring their device during the orientation day.
  - We can do a quick check and make sure your student is good to go.
  
- What will the schedule look like for students in the SLC?
  - At this time, guidance has not been posted for the SLC; however, as we move toward bringing students into the building, we will look at hosting small groups, offering contact etc.
  - At this time, we have several SLC assistants who will work to coordinate one on one meeting times with students during CDL.
  
- Will students be receiving Student ID Cards?
  - During the student orientation days, we will also have the school photographer there taking pictures and students will receive their ID cards after.
  
- How can I access items left in the building last year?
  - Please contact the main office, M-F between 8:00 and 3:30. We will arrange a pick-up time; however, please note, items will not be kept indefinitely. Please schedule a time ASAP.
  
- What do schedule changes look like?
  - At this time, cohorts are fairly set. We did our best to honor student elective requests, but are limited based on course offerings and distance learning. If students need to swap between an A/B after returning to hybrid, we will do our best to work with family needs.
