Can you discuss the staffing changes for the year?	Please take a look at our website. Our teachers are updating their 'About Me'. We will have those up soon. <a href="#">Staff Directory</a>
Will there be training and supports for parents to learn the Google platform for the meetings and assignment management? or even tips and tricks guides! 😊	Yes! Teachers will provide tech help during the individual meetings between Sept. 14-25. We will also send out some tips and tricks to help with a smooth transition.
Zoom or Google Classroom?	Both! Live sessions will be held through Zoom. Teachers will have a Google Classroom and SeeSaw (more to come on that soon).
Can working parents choose CDL, but access content/videos predominantly in the evenings, is that ok?  Is it required that CDL kids participate in Specials?	Yes, all live sessions will be recorded and posted if students can not access during the day.  Students are encouraged to participate in specials. Just like core subjects, there are standards that will be taught and assessed.
Can you give me an idea of what a day for a Kindergarten students is going to look like?	Please see the sample schedule in the slide presentation. All schedules will be developmentally appropriate (live lessons, small groups, independent work, specials, breaks and lunches).
Is the CDL option for Kiddos Mon through Fri? I miss part of this meeting and I have an incoming Kinder and a 1st grader.	Yes. Both CDL and Edmentum is Monday-Friday. The CDL will be live lessons M, T, Th, Friday with recorded lessons/activities on Wed. That is the day that we have for Professional Development and time for our teachers to get support.
Is there an example schedule for a day on Edmentum? And how many hours a day are the students on Edmentum everyday?	Elementary: Students should participate in daily instruction on average, 20-40 minutes per day/per subject, depending on their child's age.
If the work is turned in on the day but did not do the live part for a day here or there would the work being turned in count as attendance?	Yes, that would count for attendance.
What does PE look like at home?	We are in the process of working out what that looks like. There will be some live lessons and

	possibly some recorded lessons.
When will we or will we get additional Chrome books?	We are planning on passing those out during your individual meetings Sept. 14-25 for CDL. More information will be coming soon.
How can we best support your efforts?	We would love encouragement, grace and flexibility as this is a new experience for us all.

So we have to use the school computers? I bought my son a chrome book last year and it worked well for distance learning	We are recommending using the district ChromeBooks as the tools teachers will be using will be pre-installed and the computers have our district security measures in place.
When is the cutoff date for switching between CDL and Edmentum?	September 18
Will the Chrome books we have need to come in for updates/downloads?	The tech department is working on this. Please be on the lookout for this guidance coming soon.
6th graders usually go to the other teacher for different subjects, how will that work?	6th graders will still be switching teachers. The teachers will explain how that will look during your individual meetings.
