2020 – 2021 School District Goals

• **Academic Achievement and Student Success**

Increase Attendance

-Each school will increase attendance by 5%. This will be measured as follows: 90% of the students will attend school at least 90% of the time.

Increase Graduation Rates

-Each of our high schools will increase their 4-year cohort graduation rate by 3% (Baseline is the 2019 graduation).

-The final goal is to get to 95% or greater for a four-year cohort graduation rate.

-Increase 9th grade on track at each high school by 10%.

-Increase Dual Credit attainment by 5% per year.

Increase implementation of PBIS systems and Decrease Behavioral Exclusions

-Grades K-12 will increase implementation of Tier 1 and Tier 2 behavior support systems as measured by an overall increase of 15% in PBIS Tiered Fidelity Inventory scores at each building.

-Grades K-6 will reduce exclusions (suspensions and expulsions) by 7%.

-Grades 7-12 will reduce exclusions (suspensions and expulsions) by 10%.

-All secondary schools will participate in Project PRIDE professional development for implementation of Restorative Practices, and increase their overall score on the SWPRD (the assessment of implementation of RP) by 25% from the beginning to end of the 2020-2021 school year.

-Elementary schools will evaluate the project PRIDE training materials and determine what modifications are appropriate for K-6.

Align K-12 Mathematics

-Beginning in the month of September, the Teaching and Learning Administrators, and Technology Administrator will meet monthly to develop a strategic plan for curriculum adoption for math for grades K-6.

-By March 2021, the mathematics adoption committee will make recommendations to the board for purchase for the implementation to begin fall 2021 and this will complete the standard K-12 Math alignment.

Continue to Align K-12 AVID Implementation and Strategies

-80% of our classrooms will have evidence of AVID strategies being implemented. Walk through data will be used as a measure for this goal.

• **Increase Student Engagement**

-Increase enrollment stability across the district

-Increase student academic engagement

-Increase community engagement around student success

-Create new ways to connect students and families with the district

-Maximize the instructional value of the investment in technology via the full implementation of the Triple E Framework

• **Create an Equity Plan and Provide Culturally Specific Outreach to our Growing Hispanic Community**

The Superintendent will host the following community meetings with the help of the Hispanic Family Liaison:

1) Monthly meetings of a parent advisory group

2) 4 community open forum meetings - 2 in Newport and 2 in Lincoln City

3) 3 Hispanic family workshops on topics such as anti-bullying, school district navigation, parenting for academic success
