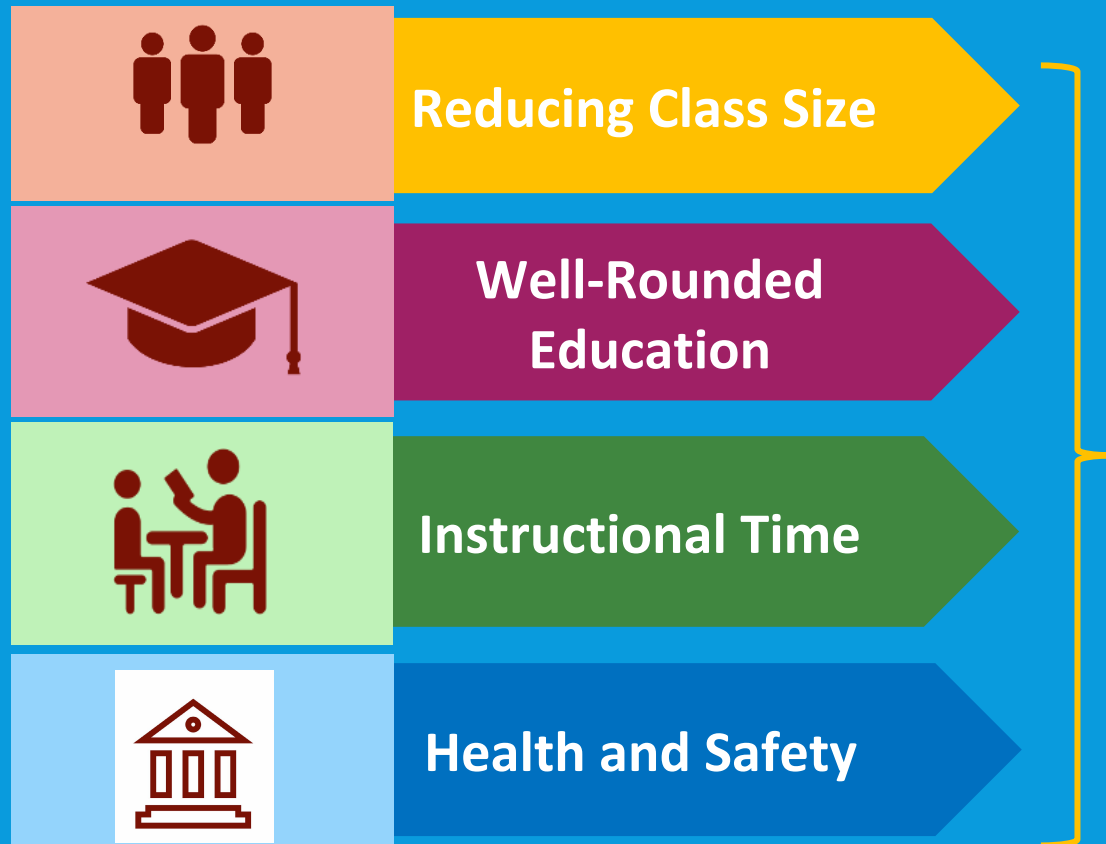
STUDENT SUCCESS ACT

Student Investment Account

- ❖ 68.74% reduction of original expected award
 - ❑ Original expected award \$4.6m
 - ❑ Updated expected award \$1.4m

- ❖ Need to revise our priorities and present an updated plan publicly with the opportunity given for public comment
- ❖ Grant Agreement posted on LCSD website at www.lincoln.k12.or.us
- ❖ Board must approve Grant Agreement - will be retroactively effective 7/1/20
- ❖ Longitudinal Growth Goals suspended and replaced with “Progress Markers”

Four Categories for the Student Investment Account

Eligible applicants are required by law to use these categories to:

1. Meet students' mental and behavioral health needs
2. Increase students' academic achievement and reduce disparities for focal populations
