You can qualify for HELP services if your student or family are living

- ◆ In an emergency or transitional shelter
- ◆ In a motel, hotel, RV park, or campground
- ◆ In a vehicle, park, public space, or abandoned building
- ◆ Substandard housing (lacking utilities, kitchen or toilet; infested with vermin or mold; or presents dangers to children)
- ◆ Shared housing with others due to economic hardship, loss of housing or similar reason
- ◆ Students not living in the physical custody of a parent or legal guardian and in one of the above situations

WE CAN HELP!

HELP works with the student and/or family to eliminate barriers related to school attendance and success.

Services include:

- ◆ Help with school supplies & school fees
- ◆ Donated student clothing and shoes
- ◆ Meal programs
- ◆ Information and help with internet resources
- ◆ Enrichment programs & classes
- ◆ Help with school transportation
- ◆ Support with credit recovery & filling out the FAFSA
